Swift Kick Technical Requirements (DFT Sessions)

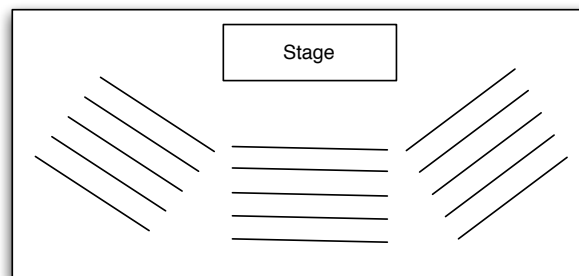
General notes: DFT sessions are interactive. The group will be moving out of chairs (preferably not desks) and it sometimes helps if there is another area in the same room or near by without chairs for standing activities.

1. A proper room for the performance, including VERY GOOD lighting (a bright setting) with heating/cooling, in good condition, without visual distractions on the walls. Please avoid rooms with high walk through traffic, eating, video games etc. If walk through traffic is unavoidable, set pathways to channel traffic and reduce distraction.

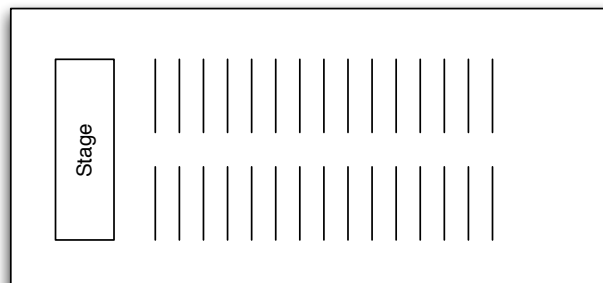
2. Chairs set to the configuration below. Key theme is grouped closely together as near to the speaker as possible. Please limit the number of chairs and pull out extra as needed to avoid the crowd spreading out. Alternatively, tape off the back rows prior to entry to increase crowd density.

3. One computer projector with PC input cable. (Presenters travel with MacBook Pro Laptops. Presenters will bring converters for standard connection PC input cable.)

4. One large screen for use with projector and of adequate size for venue.

5. 4 electric outlets approximately 30' in front of screen to plug in laptop and back up projector if needed.

6. A stereo plug hooked into house sound. Presenters travel with iPods for pre, during and post session music. iPod has standard 1/8 inch mini-plug for audio out (normally used for headphones). Please make sure the mini-plug is **stereo**.

7. For groups larger than 70 participants, or in rooms with very high ceilings, please provide one wireless lapel microphone and one wireless hand held microphone (both plugged into house sound system). Presenters are very active during the sessions so wireless is needed.

8. Please have an A/V person on hand to help setup equipment.
